<sup>2</sup> On behalf of the Republic of Poland, subject to ratification, the undersigned recognises as compulsory *ipso facto* and without special agreement, in relation to any other Member of the League of Nations or State accepting the same obligation, the jurisdiction of the Permanent Court of International Justice in conformity with Article 36, paragraph 2, of the Statute of the Court, for a period of five years, in any future disputes arising after the ratification of the present declaration with regard to situations or facts subsequent to such ratification, except in cases where the parties have agreed or shall agree to have recourse to another method of peaceful settlement.

The present declaration does not apply to disputes:

- (1) With regard to matters which, by international law, are solely within the domestic jurisdiction of States; or
- (2) Arising between Poland and States which refuse to establish or maintain normal diplomatic relations with Poland; or
- (3) Connected directly or indirectly with the world war or with the Polono-Sovietic war; or
- (4) Resulting directly or indirectly from the provisions of the Treaty of Peace signed at Riga on March 18th, 1921; or
- (5) Relating to provisions of internal law connected with points (3) and (4).
