<sup>2</sup> Following the declaration of acceptance of the optional clause of the Protocol of Signature concerning the Statute of the Permanent Court of International Justice made by the representative of Lithuania at Geneva on January 14th, 1930, I hereby recognise on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania as compulsory *ipso facto* and without special agreement on condition of reciprocity the jurisdiction of the Permanent Court of International Justice in accordance with Article 36, paragraph 2, of the Statute of the Court for a further period of five years, taking effect as from January 14th, 1935.

<sup>3</sup> The procedure provided by Article 19 of the International Convention for the Suppression of Counterfeiting Currency, signed at Geneva on April 20th, 1929, for the settlement of any disputes which might arise between the High Contracting Parties relating to the interpretation or the application of the said Convention, shall not be applied in the case of a dispute between Poland and the Free City of Danzig.
