NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS.

Geneva, March 3rd, 1928.

The Secretary-General has the honour to inform the Council that the Free City of Danzig has expressed its intention of becoming a party to the Commercial and Navigation Treaty concluded between Poland and Estonia on February 19th, 1927 and that the High Commissioner of the League of Nations at Danzig sees no reason to exercise the right of veto provided for under Article 6 of the Danzig Polish Treaty of November 9th, 1920, in respect of this Treaty

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS.

Geneva, April 17th, 1928.

The Secretary-General has the honour to advise the Council that he has just been informed by the High Commissioner of the League of Nations at Danzig that the Polish and Danzig Governments have agreed, in accordance with paragraph 2 of Article 19 of the Treaty between Poland and the Free City of Danzig of November 9th, 1920, to extend the appointment of M. DE LOES as President of the Danzig Port and Waterways Board for a further period of three years, as from April 24th, 1928. M. DE LOES has consented to continue in office.
